



IAU COMPETITION RULES FIELD CROSSBOW 2005

Revised 1st January 2005

Art. 303 TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL COMPETITIONS

303.1 At **WC** and **RC**, Team and Individual competitions will be conducted in accordance with these Competition Rules. Refer also to separate documents “**Guidelines for Organisers of IAU Championships**” and “**Guidelines for IAU Cup Events**”, and Art. 350 Finals Competition Rules.

303.2 Team Competitions: Each federation has the right to enter **four (4)** teams, which will be made up only of Nationals from that country. The constitution of teams shall be:

MEN: Three (3) competitors;
WOMEN: Three (3) competitors;
JUNIORS: Three (3) competitors (either sex);
CADETS: Three (3) competitors (either sex)

For Indoor competitions federations has the rights to enter up to three (3) teams in each category which will be made up of Nationals from the Country. The Teams to consist of three (3) competitors which may be made up of a mixture of Men-Women-Juniors.

303.2.1 **Mixed teams (both sexes) are permitted:** Where a federation has not enough competitors to enter a full team they may take part with a mixed team. Such teams shall be classified in Men’s Team Competition.



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303.3 Substitute Competitors:

Federations may select members as team reserves. They must be listed by name and substituted in order of listing. Such substitutes may only be made with the consent of the **IAU Field TC**. No substitutions will be permitted after the start of the first Competition round.

303.4 Individual Competitors:

303.4.1 Each participating National Federation has the right to enter **one (1) Team** consisted of three Shooters (see article 303.2) and further **one individual Competitor** in every category.

303.4.2 Federation, which does not have enough competitors to enter a full team may enter individual competitors.

303.4.3 The reigning individual World and Regional (continent) Champions (article 308.2) have to right to participate in the next **WC** and **RC** as individual competitors, in addition to the maximum team size restrictions.

303.5 Individual Competitions:

In Individual Competition are registered all Team members. Scores from the team events and results of **one (1) individual Competitor** (article 303.4.1) are used to determine the individual results.



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- 303.6 **Juniors and Cadets:**
Competitors, they have not attained the age of 21 years in first Competition day, they may compete in category Cadets or Juniors.
- 303.6.1 Competitors, they have not attained the age of 18 years in first Competition day, they may compete in category **Cadets** (either sex).
- 303.6.2 Competitors, they have not attained the age of 21 years in first Competition day, but attained the age of 18 years, they may compete in category **Junior** (either sex) (article 308.2.1).
- 303.7 **Seniors:** Seniors may compete in a “Cup” Competition (individual, non–title event shot separately from or concurrent with the championship event) provided the competitor has reached the age of 55 years on or before the first day of the Competition. Each national federation may enter up to three (3) competitors in the Senior Individual event.
- 303.7.1 If any national federation of any reasons cannot cover starting fee of her nominated Competitors in category seniors, they may so do it ourselves.
- 303.8 **Team and Individual Competitions:** WC and RC will be decided on a Double IR 900 Round shot one round per day over two (2) days of Competition according to these Competition Rules. Men, Women, Juniors shall shoot together, competing for separate team and individual titles and awards. Senior competitors may compete for separate individual awards (refer to Art. 303.7).

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- At Indoor **WC** and **RC** it will be decided on the respective round shot at 25 metre **IR 600** round, at 18 metre **IR 600** round at 10 metre **IR 400** round.
- 303.9 **Team Officials:** Each participating National Team shall be represented by a Team Manager (**NTM**). A **NTM** may be a competitor or non-competitor. The **NTMs** shall generally represent their team in all matters pertaining to the championships.
- The **NTMs** shall:
- contact the **OC** as soon as possible after arrival,
 - attend Team Managers’ Meetings as necessary, and,
 - accompany their teams during equipment scrutineering.
- The **NTMs** shall represent their teams in the event of disputes either to the **OC** or the International Judges Committee (**IJC**). Each National Team may also be represented by an Assistant Team Manager (Coach).
- One person may act simultaneously as **NTM** for not more than two (2) federations.
