



## IAU COMPETITION RULES FIELD CROSSBOW 2005

Revised 1<sup>st</sup> January 2005

### Art. 310 RECORDS

310.1 **WORLD RECORDS** (individual and team) may be established in all recognised IAU Men's, Women's and Juniors' events in **WC, RC, IC and CE** which have been conducted in accordance with these Rules.

310.2 **REGIONAL RECORDS** can only be recognised if set at **WC, RC, IC** or **CE** provided such events are conducted in accordance with these Rules.

310.3 **WORLD AND REGIONAL RECORDS** will be recognised for the following rounds and distance scores:

**Team Records:** IR 900 Single Round, **IR 1800** Double Round; 25 and 18 metre IR 600 Single and Double round, 10 metre IR 400 Single and Double round.

**Individual Records:** IR 900 Single Round, **IR 1800** Double Round including finals event, Indoor 25 metre and 18 metre IR 600 Single and Double Round including final event. 10 m IR 400 Single and Double Round including final event.

**Single Distance Scores:** **IR 65m, IR 50m, IR 35m**, 25m, 18m and 10m

310.3.1 Records can only be established in the category in which the competitor is entered, i.e. a Junior competitor can only establish a Junior Record if he is shooting in the Junior category, even though he may have shot a score higher than the existing Men's, Women's or Seniors' record.

310.4 The scoring shall be conducted in strict compliance with Article 325 of these Rules.

310.5 World and Regional Records shall be maintained in a Register revised by the **TC**. Lists of Records should be distributed to member federations at reasonable intervals.

310.5.1 **Claims for World Records:** The arbalist must submit a claim for a new World Record to the Chairman of the Field **TC** within one (1) month of the Competition.

Such claim(s) shall be supported by: original score sheet(s) duly signed on the day of the Competition by the arbalist, the **DOS** and the chairperson of the **OC**; a copy of the official result list.

Subject to the above provisions being met and the receipt of a **NEGATIVE** Drug Test report on the arbalist in question (where applicable), the **TC** Chairman will ratify the record and inform the arbalist and the host federation to that effect, within one (1) month of receipt of the Drug testing result.
