



IAU COMPETITION RULES FIELD CROSSBOW 2005

Art. 318 INTERNATIONAL TARGET ROUNDS

318.1 On **WC, RC, IC** and **CE** sanctioned by the **IAU**, only the outdoor **IR 1800, IR 65, IR 50** and **IR 35** shall be shot. Round **IR 1800** shall be shot over two (2) days of Competition for three distances: 65m, 50m, 35m and final shooting shall be shot on third day in accordance with article 350. Rounds **IR 65, IR 50** and **IR 35** shall be shot only on second day of **WC, RC, IC** or **CE**.

318.1.1 **Round IR 1800** shall be shot in two days on distance 65m, 50m and 35m this way:

Day „ one" begins on distance 65m, then on 50m and ends on 35m. The 65 m and 50m shall be shot on 60 cm diameter target face and 35m is using three spot target face type Vegas. The results of the first day (all three distances) determines Team Results (Art. 303.2).

Two (2) ends of three (3) sighter bolts are permitted at the commencement of the 65m distance in 5 minutes. One end of three (3) sighter bolts is permitted at the commencement of the 50 m and 35 m distance. Such sighter ends shall not be scored. Sighters shall be shot in accordance with (Art. 323).

Day „ two" begins on distance 35m, then on 50m and ends on 65 m. The results on individual distances determines results on rounds **IR 35, IR 50** and **IR 65** (see Arts. 318.2, 318.3 and 318.4).

Result **IR 1800** after two (2) days determines Team Result (Art. 303.2) and qualification on finale of individuals according to article 350.

Third day **WC, RC, IC** and **CE** shall be shot finale according to article 350 and determines a winner in individual categories in Round **IR 1800**.

318.1.2 **Round IR 35** consist of 30 bolts on distance 35 m on 40 cm diameter three spot target face type Vegas. Two (2) ends of three (3) sighter bolts is permitted at the commencement is of this distance in 5 minutes.

318.1.3 **Round IR 50** consist of 30 bolts on 50 m distance using 60 cm diameter target face. One end of three (3) sighter bolts is permitted at the commencement is of this distance in 5 minutes.

318.1.4 **Round IR 65** consist of 30 bolts on 65 m distance using 60 cm diameter target face. One end of three (3) sighter bolts is permitted at the commencement is of this distance in 5 minutes.

318.2.1 Indoor **IR 1200 (2 x IR 600)** round shall consist of 60 Bolts at 18 or 25 metres using 25 cm or 40 cm Face. Highest possible score 1200 points.

Two (2) ends of three (3) sighter bolts are permitted at the commencement of the Competition, such sighter ends shall not be scored.

Sighters shall be shot in accordance with (Art. 323).

318.4 Indoor Rounds:

The following indoor rounds may be used for the purposes of IAU sanctioned Indoor Competitions (Art. 301.5) and International Target Crossbow Mail Matches.

Note: Such mail scores shall not be recognised as **WC** or **RC** Records.

318.4.1 IAU 18 m 600 Round:

60 Competition bolts from 18m using 25 cm full range face.

Possible score 600 points. Three (3) bolts shall be shot per end. At the beginning of a round, two (2) ends of three (3) sighter bolts shall be permitted. Such sighter bolts shall not be scored.

318.4.2 IAU 25 m 600 Round:

60 Competition bolts from 25m using 40 cm reduced target face.

Possible score 600 points. Three (3) bolts shall be shot per end. At the beginning of a round, two (2) ends of three (3) sighter bolts shall be permitted. Such sighter bolts shall not be scored.

318.4.3

IAU 10 m 400 Round:

40 Competition bolts from 10 m using a 25 cm target face.

Possible score 400 points. Four (4) bolts shall be shot per end (Time allowed three (3) minutes), each bolt at a separate 25 cm face. At the beginning of a round, two (2) ends of four (4) sighter bolts shall be permitted. Such sighter bolts shall not be scored.

Special 10 m Scoring:

A bolt which touches the dividing between two scoring zones will count as the lower value, i.e. to score 10 points, a bolt must lie fully inside the 10 zone without touching the 10 ring.
